Pattern 1 - Defelct Double Weave

Here's how:

Number of ends: 324 (plus double floating selvedge on each side)

Sett: 16epcm (40epi)
Warp length: 5m (196ins)
Width in the loom: 20cm (8ins)

Finished size: $4.6 \text{m} \times 19 \text{cm} (181 \times 7\frac{1}{2} \text{ ins})$

Weave structure: Double deflect

Warping and Weaving

Wind the warp in the colour sequence of four threads grey followed by four threads red.

Weave in the colour sequence as the warp, four grey followed by four red.

Hint: Always go over the floating selvedge when taking the shuttle in and under on the way out – except for the **first row** of each red section – go under both floating selvedges - on the way in and the way out.
